

## Facility types identified for permitting in Vermont

- Backyard
- Community/communal composting – multi family/ condo assoc, etc.
- Agricultural
  - make and use on site
  - make and use and/or sell
  - inputs from other farms as part of farm nutrient management
  - mortality composting
- On-site –
  - make and use
  - institutions, resorts, businesses, etc. other than ag sites
- Source separated organic waste (SSOW)  
(Can include pre and post consumer food scraps and food soiled 'dirty' non-recyclable paper products, yard trimmings, wood, garden and field crop residuals that have been separated by the generator)
- Research & Demonstration
- Mortality – commercial – take carcasses from farms/roadkill
- Yard Debris
  - clean
  - with dog and cat waste, and/or non-biodegradable trash
- Chip & Grind
- MSW / biosolids
- Vermiculture
- Bioremediation – contaminated soil
- Landspread  
(Used when there is a large quantity of woody material and yard waste – eg. after a hurricane - that is chipped and spread on land. Generally not composted.)
