




How much wasted food is in our trash?



2023 Waste Composition Study: Happening this Year!










2018 Data:



~20% of trash is food and food scraps (~77,000 tons/year)

Composting this would reduce emissions equal to taking over 9,500 vehicles off the road each year

Depackager and Microplastics

- Act 170 An Act Relating the Regulation of Depackaging Facilities
- Moratorium on new depackaging facility certifications in Vermont until DEC adopts rules.
- Stakeholder's group report complete on recommendations:
 - Hierarchy, Source Separation, Proper use of depackagers
- Study Microplastics & PFAS in food waste via EPA P2 Grant



Compost Operator Training 10 courses since 2011
